Nicole's Dream Wires Laser Show Rivals

ARLINGTON HEIGHTS, Ill. (Sept. 26, 2003) - Nicole's Dream, a recent purchase by the Dare To Dream Stable #4, remained perfect for her new connections with a front-stepping 1 1/2 length victory in the \$47,400 Laser Show Stakes on Friday at Arlington Park. E. T. Baird was aboard the Larry Rivelli-trained daughter of Northern Trend who navigated the "about" five furlongs over yielding turf in 58.43 seconds.

Bought for an undisclosed sum following her third-place finish in the Trenton Stakes at Monmouth Park, the 3-year-old filly quickly paid dividends with a gate-to-wire score in an optional claiming/allowance race on Sept. 4. She returned 11 days later with a track record-setting performance in a starter allowance race at the "about" five-furlong grass distance.

The Laser Show winner's share of \$28,440 boosted her bankroll to \$161,743. Her record stands at 10 wins from 20 starts and she is five for eight over the turf. Sent off as the overwhelming choice of the public, Nicole Dream's paid \$3.40, \$2.80 and \$2.40.

California invader Magarita Midnight rallied from fifth at the top of the stretch to get up for the place, paying \$4.60 and \$4.40. It was three-quarters of a length back to third-place finisher Beat Your Feet, who returned \$3.60.

Cauy, Galatea Cat, Paul's Dream, Paige's Boo and Thehoneymoonsover completed the order of finish.

Arlington Park - host to the record-breaking 2002 Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships and the Chicago area's premier Thoroughbred racetrack located in Arlington Heights, Ill. - runs a 104-day meet in 2003 through Saturday, Sept. 27. Arlington Park, whose parent company is Churchill Downs Incorporated (Nasdaq: CHDN), also operates seven off-track, simulcast-wagering facilities - Trackside Arlington Park (Arlington Heights), Trackside Quad City Downs (East Moline), Trackside Chicago, Trackside McHenry, Trackside Rockford, Trackside Waukegan and Longshots featuring Trackside OTB in South Elgin.
