Hierarchy Rules scores first win for sire Hierarch

Louis William Dodd's Hierarchy Rules showed good speed early, battling on the far turn with Wild and Risque before drawing off for a 4 1/4-length victory, capturing the first win for his Ontario-based sire, Hierarch.

Hierarch, a 15-year-old son of Diesis (GB) out of the Queen's Husar mare Highclere (GB), won twice in 22 starts over three seasons before being retired with \$25,369 in earnings. He is represented by nine foals, eight of which are of racing age, in four crops.

Hierarchy Rules is one of two winners from as many starters out of the unraced Myhtical Ruler mare T T Ruler.

Kept toward the rear of the 12-horse field, Riverside Blues saved ground until the middle of the far turn, when jockey Eddie Castro

eased out the three-year-old and sent him in a hard drive down the stretch to get in front in the final strides and win by a length in his fourth career start.

Riverside Blues is the second winner produced by the stakes-placed winning With Approval mare Classic Approval, who is a half sister to multiple graded stakes winner Class Kris, the dam of Grade 3 winner Gradepoint.

Raving Rocket turned his debut into a farce when he won the 4 1/2-furlong dash by 9 1/4 lengths.

The two-year-old charged to the lead and set fractions of :22.84 for the first quarter and :46.28 for the half-mile as he drew away from his four rivals. Never challenged, he extended his lead to finish in :52.51 while being ridden out by jockey E. T. Baird.

Raving Rocket is a half brother to Grade 3 winner Mocha Express and seven other winners produced by the winning Lord Gaylord mare Gayla.
